

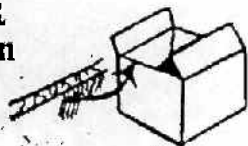
# THE DO'S AND DON'TS OF RECYCLING...

## Recycling made easy!—Join your neighbors and recycle

### CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

A cardboard box is just a box to most of us. But to recycling manufacturers, only certain boxes can be called corrugated cardboard.

**Look for:**  
**Accordion**  
**pleat inside**  
**and outside**  
**panels of the**  
**box.**



#### **DO**

- Break boxes down, fold or cut into same size as newspaper, place with newspaper.
- Remove plastic or packaging material, and
- Include with newspaper.

#### Single-Family Homes

Include in newspapers in brown paper bag or tied together with string with newspapers and place curbside.

#### Multi-Family Units

Include in newspaper bin.

#### **DON'T**

Do not include wet, soiled or wax-coated cardboard, cereal, shoe, cookie, gift or pizza boxes.

### BROWN PAPER BAGS

#### **DO**

- Include brown paper bags (kraft paper) with your cardboard and newspaper.



#### **DON'T**

Do not use brown paper bags contaminated by food or other materials.

### NEWSPAPER AND INSERTS

Newspaper and inserts must be free of excess moisture.



#### **DO**

#### Single-Family Homes

- Tie newspaper bundles with string or place in brown paper bags.
- If newspapers are placed out on a rainy day, use a garbage can lid or another protective cover.

#### Multi-Family Units

- Place newspapers in your recycling bin.

#### **DO**

Do include magazines, writing paper, packaging material, phone books or junk mail.

### GLASS

#### **DO**

- Include clear, brown or green glass in bin.
- Remove lids, rinse to remove residue.



#### **DON'T**

Do not include blue glass, light bulbs, window glass, drinking glasses or mirrors. No broken glass. No bottle caps.

### ALUMINUM and BI-METAL

#### **DO**

- Include aluminum, steel and bi-metal food and beverage cans in bin.
- Empty and rinse cans to remove food residue.



#### **DON'T**

Do not include cans used from chemicals, paint or aerosol cans. Do not include foil wrap, keys or pie plates.

### PLASTICS

#### **DO**

- Include plastics coded 1, 2, 3, on the bottom of the container, in the bin.
- Rinse containers to remove residue and remove caps.



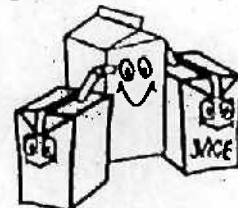
#### **DON'T**

Do not include wrapping, oil or antifreeze bottles, styrofoam cups, green vegetable trays or plastics coded 4, 5, 6, or 7.

### MILK/JUICE CARTONS

#### **DO**

- Include juice boxes and fruit drink cartons in bin.
- Rinse to remove residue; dispose of straws.
- Flatten all boxes.



#### **DON'T**

Do not include drink pouches, bags, or squeeze bottles.
